Zero Tolerance Policy

Cambrian Valley Youth Football & Cheer has a Zero Tolerance Policy regarding Code of Conduct violations by spectators or parents. Mandatory behavioral responsibilities and guidelines must be followed in all divisions. A single violation will result in that spectator or parent being removed from the field and being banned from any and all football games played by Cambrian Valley Youth Football & Cheer for the remainder of the season or up to one year. Failure to leave a game or attending any following game will result in removal by the San Jose Police Department or any other local law enforcement agency.

- Any board member has the authority to stop and end a game and to award the game win to the other team when any spectator or parent causes a disruption on the playing field.
- All spectators must remain behind the flags, roped- or fenced-off areas at all times. If videotaping the game, you must also stay behind the flags and out of the end zones. Only authorized personnel, with appropriate ID cards, the chain gang, and the team checkers will be allowed within the roped-off areas of the field.
- Do not yell instructions or criticisms to coaches or players during practices or games.
